

## Atsugewi by Jason



The Atsugewi tribe's name came from the word atsuki, which means hat creek. The tribe later became known as the Hat Creek tribe. They lived near Mount Lassen.





They made their houses with branches tied to poles. They used tule weed to make mats to cover the sides and tops of the houses.

They ate fish. They caught the fish with a cone-like basket. They also ate acorns, sunflower seeds, and roots. They used the acorns and roots to make flour.
