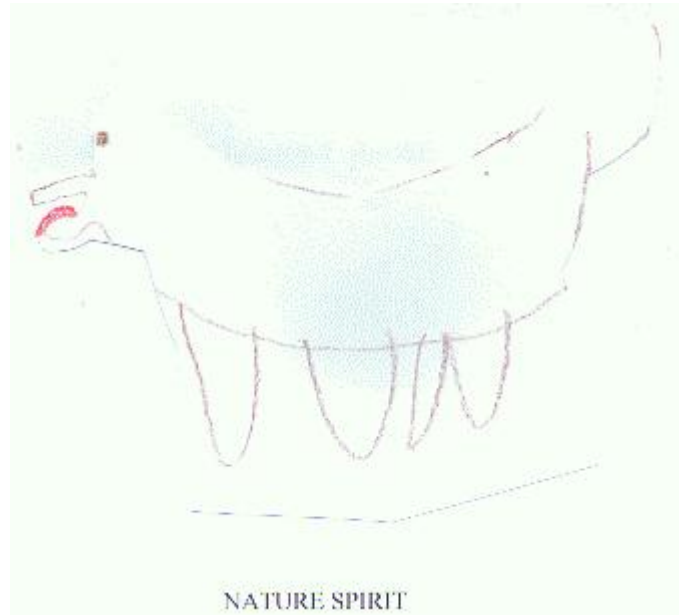


Atsugewi

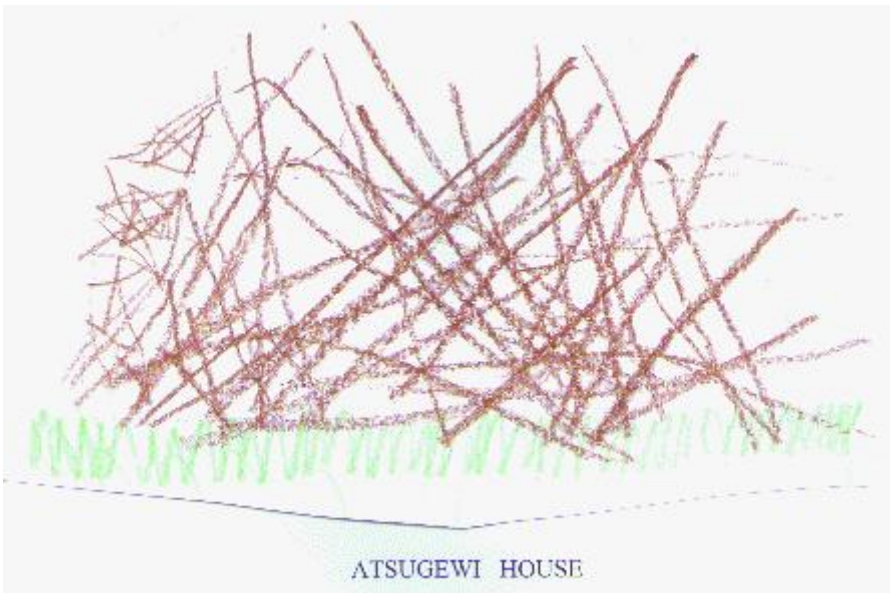
NATURE SPIRIT

Religion

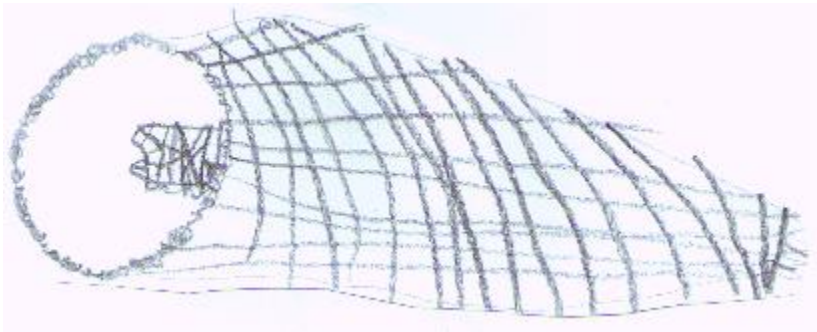
They did not believe in one god. They believed in spirits from nature. The spirits helped the Atsugewi.

They made their houses with branches tied to poles. They used tule weed to make mats to cover the sides and tops of the houses.

They ate fish. They caught the fish with a cone-like basket. They also ate acorns, sunflower seeds, and roots. They used the acorns and roots to make flour.
