
The Blackfoot Tribe

Hunting: The Blackfoot tribe killed their prey by many ways. One way was to take the buffalo to a blind cliff and, by waving torches, to scare them over the cliff. Another way that the Blackfoot tribe had to kill their animals was to dress up like the buffalo species without scaring them away. In the 18th century, the Blackfoot tribe used horses and bows and arrows



to hunt the buffalo. By using these tools that they had to hunt with, the Blackfoot tribe was able to hunt farther from their campsite.

Clothing: The Blackfoot tribe made their clothes by using buffalo. When the clothes got dirty, instead of washing them,

the Blackfoot tribe would paint them a reddish color. The men wore moccasins and leggings that covered their legs from their hips down to their ankles. The women wore long dresses that they would decorate. In



the winter, the Blackfoot people wore headbands or hats. The headbands were made by using the buffalo or the wolves.
