Cheyenne JOSEPA

The Cheyenne originally came from Minnesota, but they lived in different places like North and South Dakota, Wyoming, Colorado, and even as far as Kansas. Today the Cheyenne live two tribes, one in Oklahoma and the other in Montana.

The Cheyenne women wore deerskin dresses and the men wore breechcloths with leather pant legs tied on. The Cheyenne painted their faces for special occasions. Men wore moccasins and women wore high fringed boots.

The Cheyenne ate buffalo meat. Buffalo meat is their main source of food. Buffalo meat was the Cheyenne's prey.
