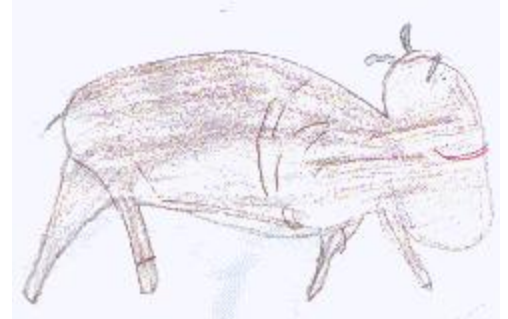


Crow

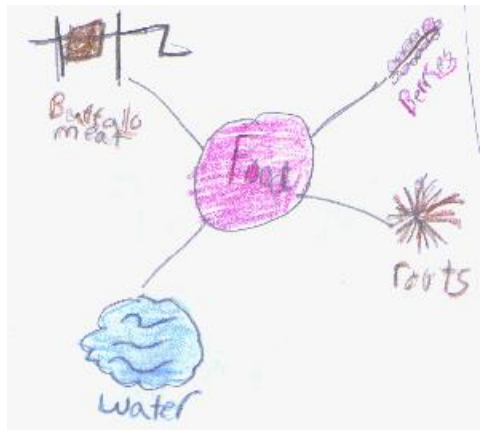


My tribe is the Crow tribe. They wore clothes made of deerskin or mountain sheepskin. All of the clothing was always decorated. Clothing was very important to

the men and women of the tribe because it kept them very warm in the winter. The Crow men wore buffalo robes and feathered headdresses. Sometimes they would hold a war shield.



The Crow hunted, and it was the most important thing they did. They hunted for buffalo. They went in a group to hunt the buffalo. They would move toward a cliff and push the buffalo down. The the men would carry it back to their camp. They would skin the buffalo and prepare the hide for clothes, robes, and tipis. They used all the meat. They dried it to eat later on. They used the bones and horns for tools and weapons. No part of the buffalo was wasted.



The Crow tribe ate meat and mostly buffalo. They roasted the meat on an open fire. They did not have pots and bowls like we have today. They made their stew or soup in a boiling stone that had been heated in the fire and placed in a long bag with the food to be cooked. The Crow people also ate berries and roots that they collected in the hunting area. They also chewed tobacco. Tobacco was an important aspect of their religious life.
