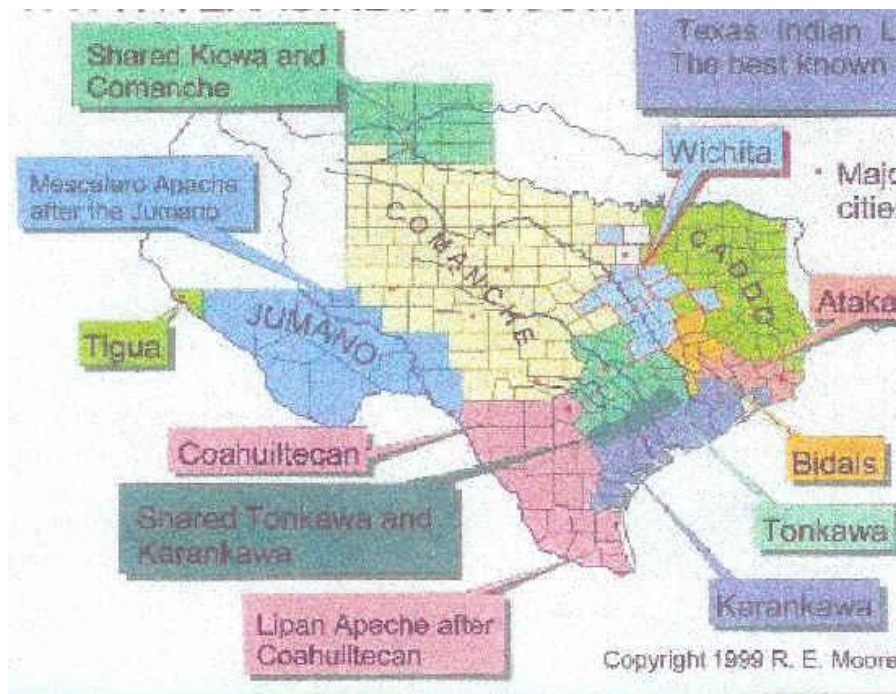
Then they got moved by the government. Then they had to walk 3,000 miles. They were going to Oklahoma . Then after that, they lived in Oklahoma .
