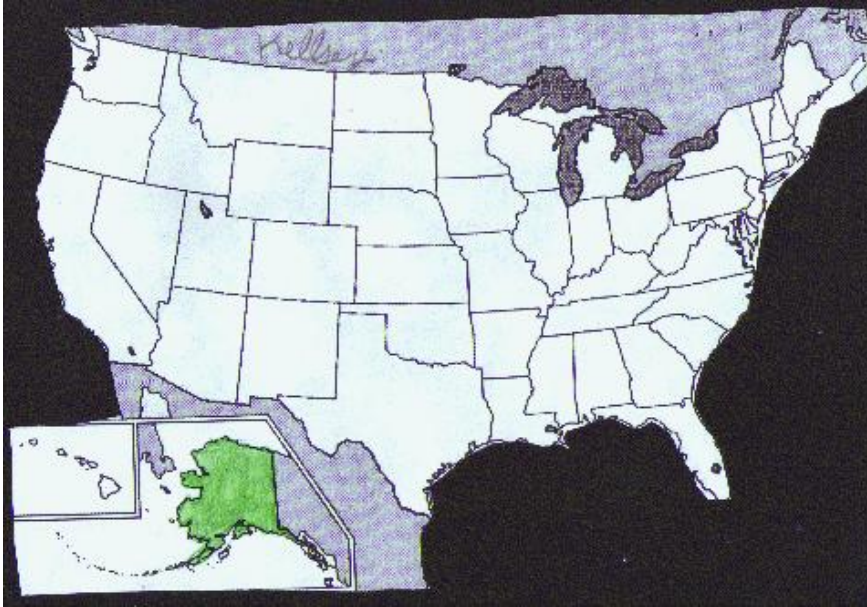

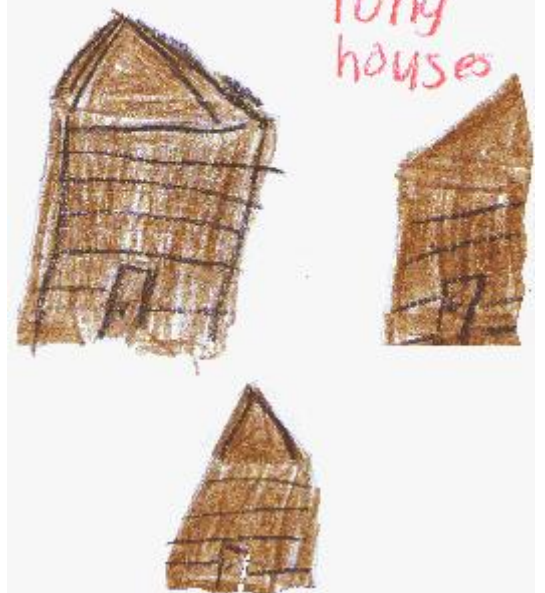
Food
