2. cramped: crowded; not enough room to move about
3. journey: a trip from one place to another
4. seeping: slowly leaking; oozing
5. settlement: a small community in a new place
6. survive: to stay alive; to hold up or withstand
7. weary: tired; needing rest
8. crates: wooden boxes used for moving or sending things
9. swamps: areas of spongy, muddy land that are often filled with water
