If you're not able to login successfully, I may hold another one next week. I'm testing this out since this is one of the district approved platforms for live video.



- 3. Download the app and open it right from the app store page.





2. That'll open a web page, where you'll see two choices: Download the Windows app **or** Join on the web instead. If you join on the web, you can use either Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome.

- 3. Your browser may ask if it's okay for Teams to use your mic and camera. Be sure to allow it so you'll be seen and heard in your meeting.
- 4. Enter your real name and choose your audio and video settings. Any unrecognizable name will not be accepted into our meeting.
- 5. When you're ready, hit **Join now**. This will bring you into the meeting lobby. I will be notified the that you're there, and I can then admit you.
