We, the third-grade teachers, are excited about the opportunity to work with your child next school year. Third grade is a fast-paced year of growth and learning. It can also be filled with fun and discovery.

To prepare for a successful school year, we have compiled a list of recommended supplies.

Notice that there are three lists. The first list is what we would like each student to bring. The second list is things we would like donated to our classes. The third contains items that we do not want the third graders to bring. Items on that list will be sent back home. Since this is a generic third grade list, you may receive some specific items that your child's teacher would like for your child to bring once school starts.

If you choose not to provide these materials for your child, that is ok. The school will still provide necessary, reasonable supplies as needed.

For 3rd grade homework, students may need to have these supplies at home: pencils, crayons, and rulers with inch and centimeter markings on them.

Classroom Supplies	For the classroom
2 boxes of sharpened #2 pencils (Ticonderoga)	extra pencils (Ticonderoga only)
Large pink erasers (not pencil top)	boxes of Kleenex
kid scissors	large pink erasers (not pencil top)
box of 24 Crayola crayons	baby wipes (for cleaning)
box of 12 Crayola colored pencils	reams of white copy paper
1 highlighter	reams of colored copy paper
2 folders with 2 horizontal pockets	Expo dry erase <u>markers</u>
box of 12 thin washable markers	DO NOT SEND
reams of white copy paper (for the teacher)	3-ring binders
a pencil box (approximately 9" x 6" x 2")	calculators
1 thin black dry erase <u>marker</u>	individual white boards
Composition book	large marker sets
4 spiral notebooks	large pencil boxes
