Classroom Supplies	
2 folders with 2 horizontal pockets	Supplies for the Classroom (supplies shared as a class)
2 spiral notebooks	facial tissues
composition book	1 or 2 reams of copy paper
one pencil box (approximately 9" x 6" x 2")	
The following items need to fit into the pencil box - measurements are above:	PLEASE DO NOT SEND
1 thin black dry erase marker	individual white boards
kid scissors	large marker or art sets
box of 24 Crayola crayons	large pencil boxes
large pink eraser (no pencil tops)	3-ring binders
*box of sharpened #2 pencils (Ticonderoga)	calculators
*1 box of thin markers and/or colored pencils (8 - 12 in a box)	permanent markers
*glue sticks	items that will not fit easily in the desk
Check with the teacher the first week of school for possible additional items or changes. *Items with an asterisk above may also be used for shared supplies depending on the class.
