Early Learning in the Murrieta Valley Unified School District

MVUSD welcomes all children to our Preschool, Transitional Kindergarten, and Kindergarten programs and will help them take flight at every stage. Here are some things to consider when launching your child's educational journey.



Preschool

Age:

18 mo. - 3 yrs. old and 4 year olds with DOB 6/3/19 and later.

Hours:

Part-Day AM: 8-11am Part-Day PM: 12-3pm **Extended Day:** 7am-5:30pm

Fees: Fee-based sliding scale or free for qualifying families

In Preschool I will...

- ...explore letters, numbers and symbols
- ...explore pre-math and science concepts
- ...be curious and participate in hands-on investigative play
- ...explore body awareness and movements through sensory play
- ...strengthen hand muscles through playdough, coloring, lacing, and cutting
- ...participate in cooperative play
- ...explore friendships and sharing



Age:

Half Day:

- Free
- AM/PM Sessions
- · Breakfast or lunch

Extended Day Option:

- Fee-based or free for qualifying families
- Early learning enrichment program through the end of the school day
- Before/after school care also available



In TK I will...

- ...learn my letters and sounds
- ...develop math concepts like sorting and patterning
- ...learn to count and recognize numbers through play

- ...develop my motor skills
- ...build my core strength through play (catch, run, jump)
- ...cut, write, and draw to develop my hand strength

SOCIAL

- ...develop friendships
- ...learn to deal with emotions appropriately
- ...learn how to speak confidently in full sentences

Kindergarten

Age:

5 DOB 9/2/17-9/1/18

Half Day:

- AM/PM Sessions
- Breakfast or lunch

Extended Day Option:

- Fee-based or free for qualifying families
- Enrichment activities through the end of the school day
- Before/after school care also available

In Kindergarten I will...

ACADEMIC

- ...learn to read words and sentences
- ...learn to write words and sentences
- ...learn to add and subtract numbers up to 10

PHYSICAL

- ...develop my pencil grasp for writing
- ...establish left to right dominance
- ...learn to run, skip, pedal a trike, and toss and catch a ball

- ...learn how to express feelings to friends and teachers
- ...understand how to follow directions
- ...collaborate with my classmates

PHYSICAL

Preschool, Transitional Kindergarten. & Kindergarten



What is MVUSD's Preschool program?

MVUSD's Preschool is a comprehensive early childhood developmental program for children ages 18 months to 4 year olds with DOB 6/3/19 and later. The district's holistic approach focuses on meeting the needs of the whole child while supporting families in this developmental stage. Preschool learners will explore and learn through investigation and meaningful play while engaging in age-appropriate hands-on activities led by child development professionals.

What are the Preschool hours?

Full day Preschool is open from 7am to 5:30pm. Part-day Preschool has two sessions. The am session is 8am to 11am; the pm session is from 12pm to 3pm.

What is the cost for Preschool?

There are two options based on family income eligibility: free or sliding scale. Income guidelines are listed on the MVUSD website <u>earlylearning.mvusd.org</u>.

What are the locations of the Preschools?

All MVUSD elementary school sites based on enrollment.

What is MVUSD's Transitional Kindergarten (TK) program?

TK is a grade level that bridges Preschool and Kindergarten. It is taught by a credentialed teacher with early childhood development expertise. TK is the first year of a two-year Kindergarten program focused on activities and lessons geared towards developing the physical, social, and academic skills needed to become independent, self-confident learners.

Who is eligible for MVUSD's TK program?

Children who turn age 4 by June 2, 2023, and were born between 9/2/18-6/2/19 are eligible for TK in the 2023-24 school year. The following school year, they will automatically transition to Kindergarten.

What is the TK and Kindergarten schedule?

Both TK and Kindergarten are part-day, three-hour programs and follow an am or pm schedule.

What is the cost for TK and Kindergarten?

TK and K are free. There is no cost to enroll in am or pm class.

What are the locations of the TK and Kindergarten programs?

All MVUSD elementary school sites. Space is limited and depending on time of enrollment, the school may be impacted.

Who is eligible for MVUSD's Kindergarten program?

Children with a DOB between 9/2/17 through 9/1/2018 are eligible for Kindergarten.

What is the extended day option for TK and Kindergarten?

We are offering a fee-based (free for qualifying families) extended day option that provides age appropriate enrichment activities through the end of the school day. Note: This is separate from SEED, our before and after school program.

Is there a before or after school program for TK and Kindergarten students?

Yes! MVUSD proudly offers wrap around sessions, known as SEED, to provide a full-day of school for our early learners. However, space is limited. For more information please visit our district website.
