Dear Wildcat Families.

I know 6-week grades went out last week and although we are all trying our best during this virtual platform, we still feel that we have too many D/F grades. Please do not panic and just know that all schools within the district are facing similar issues. Here at WSMS, we are going to do some student outreach as well as workload reflection to see if we can mitigate some of these grades.

Below are some things that we think may help in getting better engagement and grades before next grading period:

- Talk with your student about netiquette and screen expectations especially when teachers ask. (<u>see</u> <u>attached DSC netiquette</u>). This alone has shown dramatic increase in engagement which directly relates to better grades.
- Please remember that the school day isn't over at 12 p.m. Teachers are available through their virtual office hours.
- Staff/Teachers will utilize Friday's office hours as designated outreach and family support time until October 30th.
- All staff will be reaching out to families via e-mail, DM and phone to make connection on ways to support struggling students.
- Prioritize assignments, especially the ones in core classes.
- E-mail your teachers and communicate your concerns/issues that you are having (if they don't know, they can't help).
- Please, Please, Please hang in there! WE are living in difficult times and we
 understand, but don't give up! Communicate any concerns and/or celebrations,
 because we are here to support you!

Attendance calls are now going out through the district for students that do not log-in during any given period. Below is a small breakdown:

Teachers are required to enter either a 1, 2, or 3 as the code for each student.

- A (1) means the student never logged in or joined the session.
- A (2) means the student logged into the live meeting.
- A (3) means student didn't login to class /session, but they completed the work or assignment for that class period.



The only time you will receive a call is if your kiddo receives a (1).

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
Library Resource
