

- Mindful breathing techniques to help reduce parenting stress
- Daily mindfulness practices to increase self-awareness and positive communication
- Self-care techniques to find regulation in the midst of high stress and burnout
- Positive behavior techniques to support children with special needs
- Strategies for building heart-centered connections between parent and child
- Weekly sessions led by a trained mindful parenting facilitator
- · Community support for healing and growth
- Referrals for additional support services if needed
