

Monte Vista students,

It's time to start checking out books! We will start with weekly drive-thru book pick ups every Friday 12:30-2:30p. **You can check out a maximum of two (2) books for a check-out period of 2 weeks.** Since you are not able to browse the shelves, you will browse the virtual library. You will place your selected books on HOLD and I will pull those books on your behalf, preparing for Friday pick-up. This will repeat weekly, so if you finish your book(s) within the week and plan to return the following Friday, you can place HOLDS on new books to be picked up at the same time as you return the other books. **If you currently have books due to the library from last school year, please return those books ASAP otherwise you may check out one (1) book per 2-week period.**

**Graphic novels are the most popular books among our 3rd-5th graders. Only one graphic novel will be checked out per 2-week period. If you place a HOLD on two graphic novels, I will only check out one of those books requested.


Place HOLDS by Thursday 12p weekly. Confirmation emails for books that are ready to be picked up will be sent out Thursday afternoon.

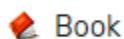

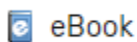
Once in your personal library page, peruse the different options and select book of your choice. You may also search for specific books in the SEARCH box at the top of the page.
