F.2 Adult Transition Program overview

Zhanna Preston, Executive Director of Special Education reported that currently the Adult Transition Program (ATP) is housed at each of the high school campuses. She shared the programmatic advantages of moving the program to an off-site location. ATP teachers also reported on the benefits of housing the program in a commercial building to better support and advance opportunities for these students.

Bill Olien, Assistant Superintendent of Facilities/Operational Services reported that commercial space adjacent to the District Support Center is currently available. He presented a schematic space plan designed to house the special needs of the ATP Program. He indicated that the cost of the lease is \$285,355 and would be funded using Community Facilities District taxes. He added that business partnerships would be explored to help defray some costs.

Mr. Olien requested direction from the Board due to the current availability of the space. The Board concurred on the concept and directed Mr. Olien to submit a lease agreement for the Board's review and action.
