E.2 Approval of employment contract for District Superintendent, Patrick Kelley, effective July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2021

Darren Daniel, Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources reported that Government Code Section 53262 and Board Policy 2121 require that final action on an employment agreement with the Superintendent occur in open session. In addition, the Brown Act requires an oral summary of the recommendation before the Board takes final action. Mr. Daniel reported out the following recommended changes to the Superintendent's current employment contract:

- 1) Proposed contract is a four-year employment contract between the Governing Board and Superintendent Kelley effective July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2021.
- 2) Proposed contract includes an annual base salary of \$240,000 (increased from \$226,161) effective July 1, 2017. He stated that within the past two years there have been cost of living adjustments, step and column adjustments, and other compensation increases provided to certificated management employees and bargaining unit members that were not provided to the Superintendent. He added that a salary gap exists between Superintendent Kelley's salary and the salary of other superintendents in similarly-sized school districts in Riverside County, and that this increase reduces but does not eliminate the gap.
- 3) Proposed contract eliminates a "me too" provision tying the Superintendent's compensation increases to certificated management employee increases. Mr. Daniel stated that instead, the contract provides for a 2.5% annual step adjustment to the Superintendent, subject to receiving a satisfactory annual evaluation.
