F. BUSINESS SERVICES

F.1 Review of Governor's Budget Proposal for fiscal year 2019/20

Stacy Coleman, Assistant Superintendent of Business Services reported that the Governor's state budget proposal includes a higher cost of living adjustment (COLA), one-time funding towards State Teachers Retirement System (CalSTRS) employer contribution rates, and significant new funding for Early Childhood Education. Mr. Coleman stated that this budget is moving in the right direction K-12, however, it is pending the May Budget Revise.

G. FACILITIES/OPERATIONAL SERVICES

G.1 Facilities and Technology Update

Bill Olien, Assistant Superintendent of Facilities/Operational Services provided an update on all facilities funding sources, Measure BB technology device purchases and long-term enrollment projections.

Richard Nowicki, partner with Baker Nowicki Design Studio, and Mr. Olien previewed conceptual facilities master plans for Murrieta Mesa High, Murrieta Canyon Academy, Murrieta Elementary, Cole Canyon Elementary, Shivela Middle, and Thompson Middle schools. Mr. Olien also shared school and district office renovations currently underway.

Board members were pleased with the conceptual facilities master plans presented and expressed support for continued research.

Consultant Clyde Murley provided information regarding installation of battery storage systems at all middle and comprehensive high schools to reduce energy costs during peak hours. He indicated that the district will be utilizing state grant funds restricted for energy management projects.
