F.1 Information regarding the adoption of Grade Eight through Eleven English Curriculum

Staff Presenters: Jennifer Schriver, Executive Director of Secondary Education, Chris Shore, Coordinator Student Support, Todd Thornburgh, Teacher, Murrieta Valley High School, Nicole Chesler, Teacher, Vista Murrieta High School, Michelle Millett, Murrieta Mesa High School

Mrs. Schriver reported that during the 2019/20 school year, a team of teachers and administrators took part in a comprehensive review and field testing of new English instructional materials for grades 8-11. Teacher presenters reviewed their decision-making process, results of field testing, and highlights of the recommended new curriculum.

Staff recommends the adoption of <u>Pearson myPerspectives English Language Arts for grade</u> <u>levels 8-11</u>. A public notice was posted on March 12, 2020, announcing that materials will be on display for public review at the District Support Center from March 13 through April 16, 2020. G.3 Filing and Positive Certification of the Second Interim Financial Report for Fiscal Year 2019/20

Bill Olien, Deputy Superintendent of Business and Operations reviewed the Second Interim Financial Report for the 2019/20 school year and multi-year projections for 2020/21 and 2021/22. He reported that total revenues are projected at \$257,900,000 with 81% of the budget funded by the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), 7% from State, 8% from Local, and 4% from Federal revenues. He reported that total expenditures are projected at \$269,100,000 with 45% expended for certificated salaries, 25% for employee benefits, 15% for classified salaries, 9% for services and other operating, 5% for books and supplies, with the balance for capital outlay/other outgoing.

Mr. Olien indicated that the district will be able to meet its financial obligations for the budget year and two successive fiscal years.
