A.6 Murrieta Valley Unified School District COVID-19 update

Staff Presenters: Patrick Kelley, Superintendent; Bill Olien, Deputy Superintendent; Darren Daniel, Assistant Superintendent Human Resources; Mary Walters, Assistant Superintendent Educational Services; Howard Dimler, Executive Director Student Support; Zhanna Preston, Executive Director Special Education and Monica Gutierrez, Public Information Officer

A.6 Murrieta Valley Unified School District COVID-19 update (continued)

Superintendent Patrick Kelley discussed the following goals provided by the California Department of Education during COVID-19 school closures: 1) provide equitable educational opportunities for all students; 2) meet nutrition needs for students as if schools were open; 3) provide resources and services to students and families to the extent possible under closure orders. He also outlined actions and expected impacts educational systems will address going forward. Such as distance learning; budget impacts for the current fiscal year and 2020/21 and beyond; students with disabilities access and equity; counseling and mental health service models; planning for rites of passage events and social connectivity needs.

Monica Gutierrez, Public Information Officer, provided updates on the numerous communications sent to staff, parents and students since March 1, 2020. Mrs. Gutierrez highlighted the Distance Learning section of the website created to guide and support parents and students with distance learning during school closures.

Mary Walters, Assistant Superintendent, Educational Services, Howard Dimler, Executive Director, Student Support and Zhanna Preston, Executive Director of Special Education updated the Board on the many efforts being undertaken during school closures, including, but not limited to: the distribution of over 2,000 electronic devices; teacher professional development for distance learning; outlining instructional components of distance learning and provided examples of teacher learning platforms; counseling and mental health support; methods for addressing the needs of special education students and accommodations necessary during distance learning; remote enrollment and registration for the 2020/21 school year;

Bill Olien, Deputy Superintendent, shared the latest information regarding fiscal impacts of the COVID-19 Pandemic at the state level and the potential impacts to K-12 education. Mr. Olien further outlined increased expenses and loss of revenues at the district level as a result of school closures. Mr. Olien's update highlighted the following divisions: 1) Nutrition Services is serving approximately 2300 "grab and go" meal packets each weekday; 2) Technology has supported the distribution of over 2000 devices to families, supported remote access for employees, launched Microsoft Teams platform in support of remote voice/video conferencing and provided helpdesk support to families and staff; 3) Student Data has provided technical support for application systems used by students and staff, developed systems to track attendance/check-in and engagement; established data privacy requirements/contracts to support additional distance learning programs; 4) Facilities is moving forward with projects slated for the summer of 2020; 5) Maintenance and Operations is providing essential functions in the areas that continue to operate during school closures.

Darren Daniel, Assistant Superintendent Human Resources provided information on employee support, safety and stability; clarified who "essential employees" and "high risk employees" are under the current Executive Orders; addressed the "Families First Coronavirus Response Act", distance working, hiring for 2020/21 and processing unemployment claims. Mr. Daniel also updated the Board on continuing conversations addressing the current changes in work environments due to COVID-19 with Murrieta Educators Association and California School Employees Association, Murrieta Chapter 223.
