# C.6 Report regarding Investigation of 2015 Group Chat and Community Input

On June 4, 2020 screenshots of a 2015 private group chat were posted publicly on social media by former Vista Murrieta High School (VMHS) students. The District asked the law firm of Best Best & Krieger, LLP to conduct an investigation regarding the District's awareness and response to racist social media screenshots in 2015 and anecdotal reports of racial discrimination, harassment, intimidation or bullying at VMHS from 2015 to the present.

Investigators Dina Harris and Jack B. Clarke, Jr. of Best Best & Krieger LLP conducted approximately 60 interviews of more than 50 different people: 12 former VMHS students, 7 of whom either participated in the 2015 group chat or saw the screenshots; 32 former or current employees; and 7 parents of current and former VMHS students. Mrs. Harris and Mr. Clarke, Jr. presented a summary of conclusions and findings, saying that there was insufficient evidence that any employee of the VMHS staff saw the group chat snapshot or had knowledge of it in 2015. However, they said they received many anecdotal reports of alleged racial discrimination, harassment, intimidation, or bullying at VMHS over the past five years and how they were handled. The complete investigation report was made available to the public on the District website.

Superintendent Patrick Kelley read a statement to the Murrieta Valley Unified School District community in response to the investigation report. He said even though the investigation did not uncover any specific actionable conduct we as a District are taking bold and decisive steps to change the culture at VMHS to ensure every student feels safe and supported.

Board members each individually commented on the findings of the investigation report and made commitments to hold the District accountable for the changes that need to be made in the culture and climate throughout the entire District. Board members acknowledged the strides the District has made towards diversity, equity, and inclusion since 2015, but said there still is a long way to go and they are committed to ensuring the necessary growth continues in order to provide an equitable educational experience for all students.

# C.7 Start of the 2020/21 School Year report

Bill Olien, Deputy Superintendent and Mary Walters, Assistant Superintendent Educational Services provided an updated on supports in place to start the 2020/21 school year in a virtual learning environment. Mrs. Walters stated that over 10,000 laptop computers and 65

hotspots have been distributed to families to date. She also discussed the next steps for offering in-person instructional services, assessments for Special Education and English learners, opening the Child Development Center and planning for childcare, as health orders will allow. Mr. Olien reviewed the required reporting of attendance and weekly engagement to the State. He also reported that current enrollment numbers are down by a couple of hundred students from projections at this time.
