b. Employee Organizations Communication

Kim Binning-Chevlin, President Murrieta Educators Association announced changes to the MEA Executive Board. Mrs. Binning-Chevlin commented on the significant challenges teachers are facing in this pandemic environment to ensure students are receiving a quality education. She stated that the MEA membership is looking forward to working together with district administration and the Board to safely bring students back on campus.

Anna Leos, President California School Employees Association, Murrieta Chapter 223 commented on the importance of safety precautions for all students and staff during the pandemic. Ms. Leos complimented Dr. Preston and Mrs. Israelsen on their willingness to work closely with classified employees while developing plans for in-person specialized special education services and the reopening of the Child Development Center.

c. Superintendent Communication

Superintendent Patrick Kelley acknowledged the enormous amount of work that staff, administration, teachers, support staff and parents are shouldering during virtual learning. He said the majority of our students are rising to the occasion, but we must remain focused on those students that are having difficulty connecting to learning in this virtual

environment. Mr. Kelley expressed his concern for the communities throughout our state that are being affected by the tragic wildfires.

d. Board Member Communication

Board member Paul Diffley thanked the teachers for their ability to innovate, create and press forward during virtual learning.

Board member Kenneth Dickson remarked that we are accomplishing extraordinary things in an extraordinary time, and said it is a compliment to the Superintendent, staff, students, families, and our community.

Board member Oscar Rivas said he has first-hand experience with the struggles parents are facing as they work from home while juggling the responsibilities of helping their children with virtual learning. He remarked that this has been a great lesson in empathy for all.

Board member Linda Lunn stated that it was amazing to witness the delivery of highquality content in a virtual learning environment and thanked the staff members for the tremendous work they are all doing.

C.6 Resuming Specialized In-Person Services for Students

Staff Presenters: Patrick Kelley, Superintendent; Howard Dimler, Executive Director, Student Support Services; Zhanna Preston, Executive Director, Special Education; Kathleen Israelsen, Director Family Services; Dale Velk, Director, Student Support Services.

Mrs. Israelsen reported that the child development center opened five classrooms for children eighteen months to four years old on August 31st, 2020, and that they are working on two plans for offering services to TK through 5th grade students. Dr. Preston outlined the plans to provide in-person individual preschool special education assessments along with other special education and English learner assessments to students. She also said they are looking forward to starting in-person special education small cohort instruction, as current health orders would allow. Mr. Dimler said plans are being developed to bring a small group of students back on campus that are having difficulty engaging in virtual learning due to connectivity problems in their households. Mr. Velk outlined the criteria for resuming youth sports and physical education small group conditioning. Mr. Kelley concluded with information on the application process for an Elementary waiver and the many different restrictions and requirements under a waiver re-opening.
