Mr. Kelley said now that the County of Riverside has moved from the purple tier to the red, less restrictive tier, of California's 4 Tier Reopening Framework staff would be presenting an overview of the in-person instructional programs planned for October and November. He stated that a much more detailed plan would be presented at the October 8, 2020 Regular Board meeting.

Mrs. Van Ryzin and Mrs. Owens provided answers to Board members' questions relating to California Department of Public Health guidelines and requirements for providing in-person instruction to students during the COVID 19 pandemic.

The Educational Services team provided an overview of elementary and secondary models for in-person hybrid instruction under the guidelines and mandates of California's 4-Tier Reopening Framework. They discussed the potential scheduling impacts of shifting from the current virtual learning to an in-person hybrid instructional program.
