# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR FIRST-TIME FRESHMEN

## CSUDH IS NOT AN IMPACTED CAMPUS

### Requirements at a Glance

To qualify for admission to CSUDH, a first-time freshman must:

- ✓ Be a high school graduate
- ✓ Have a qualifiable [eligibility index](#)
- ✓ Have completed with grades of "C" or better each of the courses in the comprehensive pattern of college preparatory [subject requirements](#). Courses must be completed prior to the first enrollment in the California State University.

Deadline to submit additional financial aid documents

# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR UPPER DIVISION TRANSFER STUDENTS

## CSUDH IS NOT AN IMPACTED CAMPUS

### Requirements at a Glance

1. Have completed 60 transferable semester units (90 quarter units)
2. Have completed at least 30 semester (45 quarter) units of general education courses, graded C or better in each course including the “The Golden Four”:
  - One Written Communication course
  - One Oral Communication
  - One Critical Thinking/Logic course
  - One Mathematics/quantitative reasoning with intermediate algebra as prerequisite.
3. Have a grade point average of 2.00 or better in all transferable college units attempted
4. Be in good standing at the last college or university attended (i.e. eligible to re-enroll at that college or university).
