Welcome back Alligators!

I hope everyone had a restful and exciting summer and is ready to come back and learn. To all the new students and families, I look forward to meeting you all and to those who have been here a while, welcome back!

As we make our way to school, every student should make it a goal to be here as much as they possibly can. Remember alligators, if your not here you are not learning. Students who attend school regularly learn more and are more successful in school than students who do not. We need to make school attendance a priority. By doing this, we are helping students to learn and accept responsibility, which is an important lesson for a successful life. Attendance patterns are formed early in life. Children who develop good attendance habits in the early grades will be more likely to continue them throughout their school career, as well as into their chosen career. Regular attendance is critically important, because students who miss school miss out on instruction. They miss out on learning experiences, class participation, and an opportunity to ask questions. As a result, they are more likely to fall behind, and they are more likely to drop out. So be mindful of days that your child misses, we value every day with your child. Every day is an opportiunity for them to grow and be successful.

Avaxat is fortunate to be able to have a professional school counselor daily in our school. As a school counselor, I feel privileged to be able to work with students and families to remove barriers to learning (e.g. Academic Skills, Social Skills and Personal Issues). Most students may see me in the classroom a few times a month giving lessons on social skills, empathy, emotion management, problem solving and/or career exploration. For students who need more help, I conduct interventions to help kids problem-solve personal issues like violence and bullying. Individually, I may be in contact with you and grade level teams about how to help students cope and thrive after traumatic events that may happen in and around our community. I provide brief counseling to students so they are able to be successful in the learning environment. If there is a greater need, I provide resources for parents to get additional help. All lessons, whether individual, group or school-wide are designed to build competencies in personal/social, academic and career development. When we remove barriers to learning and build social & life skills, students "Learn More and Respect All."

If you have concerns about how your child is doing at school, please feel free to schedule a time to talk to me about it. School counselors are always here to help! I will do my best to provide students with the support necessary for them to be the most successful student they can be here at Avaxat and beyond.
