Guy Romero, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services reported that this presentation is Part Two of a six-part series designed to provide the Board with information regarding the constructs of student outputs aligned with the Depth of Knowledge taxonomy, Mr. Romero introduced Pamela Rodden, Teacher on Special Assignment and Academic Intervention Specialist for Rail Ranch Elementary School who reviewed examples of student Common Core Math Performance tasks utilizing the Depth of Knowledge model.

MSC MUIR/DICKSON that the Board of Education of the Murrieta Valley Unified School District, under Education Code 48915 (b) and (e), expels student number 956-017-423 for the violation of Education Code 48900 (a1) and (k) for the remainder of the first semester of the 2012/13 school year and the second semester of the 2012/13 school year.
