Employee Organization Communications

Kathy Ericson, President of the Murrieta Teachers Association remarked that this is an exciting time of year. She acknowledged the work that goes into the start of the school year by district staff, teachers and support staff.

Superintendent Communications

Superintendent Patrick Kelley thanked the new student representatives for their reports. He shared that he has noticed an excitement at schools and that the focus on student engagement is very empowering. He reported that recently Board members participated in a California School Boards Association "Back to School" webcast that focused on the overwhelming number changes going on in the state, including Common Core and the new Local Control Funding Formula. He stated that education is in the midst of a shift from how things worked in the past to how they will work in the future, and although it will be a long journey he is honored to be able to say that he works alongside great individuals.

Board Communications

Trustee Barbara Muir thanked the student representatives for their enthusiastic reports. She expressed her appreciation to Mr. Bryan Boos and the Thompson Middle School choir on their excellent performance. She shared that she is looking forward to a terrific school year and thanked the faculty, leadership and support staff for a great start.

Trustee Ken Dickson echoed Mrs. Muir's comments and remarked that it was very emotional to hear students sing patriotic songs. He reflected on the 9/11 tragedy and the healing that followed. He discussed the challenges in education and encouraged students to use technology resources available to them to excel in their studies. Mr. Dickson thanked community members for their public comments. He encouraged all points of view to be heard which he said is healthy and exceptional to Americans.

Trustee Robin Crist commended principals and teachers for the wonderful Back to School Nights and said how impressed she was with teacher engagement of parents and students. Reporting as a delegate, she indicated that the Riverside County School Boards Association is in the midst of new marketing and branding, and will be reaching out to the county and school districts. Riverside County School Boards Association will join the San Bernardino County School Boards Association for their annual joint meeting on October 28, 2013 at the San Bernardino Hilton. Mrs. Crist announced that the Murrieta Scholarship Foundation is gearing up and moving to a new online student scholarship application program.

Trustee Paul Diffley referred to the number of leadership changes which have brought about a new momentum in the district. He acknowledged the maintenance and grounds staff for keeping schools in great shape, and said that he is pleased to see the new yellow natural gas school buses on the road. He thanked Thompson Middle School's choir for performing all-American songs, and spoke about the freedoms we enjoy and the ability to express our views and opinions in an open forum. Mr. Diffley is looking forward to a great school year and to visiting classrooms and departments.
