## Superintendent Communications

Superintendent Patrick Kelley thanked this evening's speakers and student representatives for their reports. He remarked that during his recent classroom visits he was truly inspired by the student learning that is occurring. He reported attending a discussion with representatives from the Legislative Analyst's Office regarding the effect that the Local Control Funding Formula will have on school districts. Trustee Ken Dickson commented on the busy start of the school year.
