Superintendent Communications

Superintendent Patrick Kelley thanked this evening's speakers and student representatives for their reports. He remarked that during his recent classroom visits he was truly inspired by the student learning that is occurring. He reported attending a discussion with representatives from the Legislative Analyst's Office regarding the effect that the Local Control Funding Formula will have on school districts. He agreed with Mrs. Ericson's remarks that it was an especially busy start of the school year, and is pleased that both teachers and students are commenting that they like what they are doing better than last year. Mr. Kelley said that he is thankful and proud to work alongside such committed individuals.

Board Communications

Trustee Paul Diffley reported visiting Monte Vista Elementary School and was in awe of what students were learning in Math and Language Arts. He indicated that during his conversations with teachers he was surprised to hear that they are more concerned about class size rather than compensation. He reported attending Vista Murrieta High School's Band Concert and was very impressed by their performance. Mr. Diffley complimented the Grounds Department on the landscape renovation at Shivela Middle School.

Trustee Robin Crist expressed her appreciation to Council PTA President, Sherrie Zettlemoyer, and the high school student representatives for their comprehensive reports. She congratulated Inspiring Student award recipients.

Trustee Ken Dickson commented on the busy start of the school year. He congratulated teachers Michelle Nechaev and Erin Rench for receiving Inspiring Student awards, and said that teaching is definitely a calling. He thanked Mrs. Zettlemoyer on her PTA report and remarked that PTA is a "force multiplier." Mr. Dickson announced that the Field of Honor Program is underway and encouraged participation in this tribute to veterans.

Trustee Barbara Muir commended Creekside High School for building a community and sense of school spirit. She announced that the Share the Harvest event at Murrieta Mesa High School, sponsored by the Interact Club, is gearing up and stated that this year they especially are requesting turkey or monetary donations since the past year's sponsor is unable to participate this year. Mrs. Muir thanked Mrs. Zettlemoyer for her informative PTA report.

Trustee Kris Thomasian thanked Mrs. Zettlemoyer for attending and providing a PTA report. She reported attending the Student of the Month breakfast and was pleased that a couple of our high school student recipients, that previously attended private school, commented that high school is challenging and that they have great teachers. Mrs. Thomasian remarked that students that pursue higher education would make great guest speakers at our high schools.
