


Why might a student benefit from working in Canvas? Students can use Canvas to:

- Access class materials (calendar, assignments, quizzes, etc.) online using any device or any browser.
- Track their progress through ongoing teacher feedback tools.
- Receive course announcements, grade notifications, etc. instantaneously on their preferred device(s).
- Easily collaborate with peers and teachers.
- Check agenda when absent.







Tests and Quizzes: For each section there will be a test and or a quiz.


Stemscores: This is our online science learning platform. Student log-in is the same as their Office 365 log-in.


→ Homework submitted online AND WORK is shown on paper & turned in. NO CREDIT will be given for online answers if work has not been shown on paper and turned in.
