

Paper Plate Bumblebee Craft

Materials.

- Paper plate
- 2. Waxed paper
- 3. Scissors
- 4. Tape
- 5. Small triangle of black paper
- 6. Yellow paint and black paint or marker

(If you don't have yellow paint, cut up 1 inch (ish) squares of yellow construction paper or tissue paper and glue those to the paper plate instead of painting.)

Intructions:

- Paint the paper plate yellow and let dry.
- 2. With black paint or markers, put on stripes.
- 3. Put on face with paint or markers OR use snips of cut up paper OR use wiggly eyes.
- Cut two wings out of waxed paper (you can trace the child's feet for these or you can just make two Ushaped wings).
- 5. Attach with scotch tape.
- 6. Cut a triangle out of black paper and tape it to the back of the bee as a stinger.


