In order to receive priority for financial aid, applications must be postmarked by close of business day on **Tuesday, March 2nd**.

- Get a **Federal Student Aid personal identification number (PIN)** at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov).
- Collect documents, including your **W-2 forms** if you worked. A list of what you need is at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).
- Attend the financial aid application workshop as stated above.
- FAFSA questions (53 -58)** is where you will need to answer whether you were in foster care.
- I filed my FAFSA application by March 2, 2010.
- Ensure that your high school counselor completes the **Cal Grant GPA verification form** by March 2, 2010.
- A Student Aid Report (SAR) will be sent to you from the Department of Education.
- Check your Student Aid Report (SAR)** to confirm the information you submitted on your FAFSA, especially your school of choice.
- Respond to any deadlines, letters or emails from your school or you will not receive federal student aid.
- A financial aid award letter will be sent from your school. Sign and return the letter by the due date.
- Contact the financial aid office at your school if you have any questions about your financial aid packet. The more you know, the more you can help yourself.

**March 2, 2010**
