B. BOARD WORKSHOP

1. Direction Setting for 2022/23 (Discussion)

Part I - Facilitator Superintendent Patrick Kelley

<u>History Walk</u>: Attendees broke up into smaller groups to review and reflect upon District Key Initiatives from 2013 - 2022. Board members expressed their confidence in the staff's ability to continue to support the key initiatives outlined in the History Walk posters.

Part II - Facilitators Mary Walters, Assistant Superintendent Educational Services and Faythe Mutchnick-Jayx, Executive Director Educational Services

<u>Data Review and Analysis</u>: Attendees broke up into two groups to discuss demographics, attendance, chronic absenteeism, graduation rates, dropout rates, A-G data and secondary "F" rates. The following topics brought to the attention of staff from student advisory groups and student surveys were discussed: mental health concerns, unhealthy coping skills, challenging student behavior, improving student-teacher relationships and managing the transition to in-person learning.

The whole group came back together to review 2021-24 LCAP Goals 1 - 4 and key components of the following grants: Elementary and Secondary Schools Emergency Relief (ESSER) III, Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant (ELOG), Educator Effectiveness Block Grant and Prekindergarten (TK) Grant, Expanded Learning Opportunities Program Grant (ELOP), A-G Grant, Special Education Grants.

The group discussed the following proposed focus areas for 2022/23: universal transitional kindergarten (TK), equity and engagement and career/college readiness. Monica Gutierrez, Public Information Officer, shared a brief overview of the 2022/23 marketing plan.

Part III - Facilitators Darren Daniel, Deputy Superintendent and James Whittington, Chief Financial Officer

<u>Balancing Priorities and Strategic Directions</u>: Discussion centered around lagging salary schedules and teacher recruitment, needed renovations to school sites, furniture, technology and equipment replacement plan, significant deficit spending in the next three budget years, transitional kindergarten expansion and inflation.

Board of Education members expressed great confidence in the staff and assured them that the goals discussed for the 2022/23 school year were in alignment with their wishes.

Mr. Kelley indicated that he would submit a report for the Board at an upcoming Board meeting.
