Dr. Cooper met with Murrieta Police Chief, Tony Conrad to discuss community policing and protection in place for MVUSD students.

Board member Kris Thomasian shared her appreciation for the safety presentation Mr. Velk provided to the Board during the last meeting. She praised the collaboration with Murrieta police, fire and Riverside County Sheriff.


