E. EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

E.1 Equity Journey Presentation

Staff Presenters: Mary Walters, Assistant Superintendent Educational Services and Tamara Dewey, Coordinator of Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, Educational Services.

Mr. Kelley welcomed Dr. Judy White, County Superintendent of Schools to the meeting and introduced Ms. Tamara Dewey as the new Coordinator of Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion.

Mrs. Walters and Ms. Dewey reviewed the District's equity efforts and journey over the last five years highlighting the establishment of parent advisory groups, professional development opportunities and attendance at the Excellence through Equity Conference. Mrs. Walters compared dashboard data from 2018 to 2019 that demonstrates the efforts have resulted in closing the achievement gap for all student groups. Ms. Dewey outlined long term equity goals for the district in the coming years.

Dr. White commended Murrieta Valley Unified School District for the decisiveness to take this journey and for having made measurable targets along the way. She stated that equity and fairness is a continuous journey and said it is important to stay mindful of the markers on this journey. Dr. White thanked Mr. Kelley for being so responsive to any issues referred from the County Office and said he is genuinely concerned about all students and families in the Murrieta Valley Unified School District.

Board members each thanked Dr. White for her comments and words of encouragement. They collectively agreed that equity conversations and efforts are very important and will enable the District to take subsequent actions, as needed. Mrs. Thomasian mentioned her excitement to see efforts being put in place for an updated and relevant Ethnic Studies course offering.
