
#### IS NATIONAL BULLY PREVENTION MONTH



As you know, we are using the Second Step program in our school. The Second Step program teaches children important skills for getting along with others and doing well in school. It also helps our school be a safe, respectful place where everyone can learn. To further help our school be a safe and respectful place, we are also going to use the Second Step Bullying Prevention Unit. In the lessons, your child will learn specific skills to help stop bullying. Students will learn how to:

- Recognize when bullying is happening
  - Report bullying to a caring adult
- Refuse to let bullying happen to themselves or others
- Be a bystander who stands up and is part of the solution to bullying

#### Second Step dassroom sel

Students will begin a new unit in their classroom this month. The new unit teaches emotion management. Students learn foundational skills about how their brain works and processes emotions. In the emotion management unit children learn how to identify and label emotions and use emotion management strategies—including stress management for older students—to calm strong feelings.



Steps for a

Use a stop signal. Using a stop signal send a message to your brain to stop and tells it it's time to redirect one's thoughts.

Some stop words that a child can use are: Stop, chill out, hold on, let's take a minute, and relax

How to Calm Down

Stopuse your signal

Name your feeling

Calm down:
breathe count use positive self-talk

Name your feeling. Your child should out loud or using their "self-talk" state the specific feeling they're feeling.
Such feeling like sad, mad, frustrated, jealous, frustrated, and/or lonely

Coping strategies such as long deep breaths, Counting to 10, positive self-talk.
Children can self-motivate by telling themselves "I got this" or "I can do it."
This could also be a good time to seek help from a trusted adult or just take a break.
