POINT RECOVERY OPPORTUNITY DUE 1 WEEK AFTER UNIT TEST

Description: For this point recovery assignment you will choose a topic relating to the material we have covered in the past unit. Your topic can be broad or specific as long as it is related to the past unit. Once you have chosen a topic you will then have the choice of creating a poster board, writing a research paper, creating a PowerPoint presentation, or a brochure. The amount of points you receive will depend on your finished product and the amount of work and effort made to a **maximum of 30 points**.

For all projects you must first have your topic approved by me at the beginning of class the day before the test.

Poster Board: Your poster must contain both *images* and *text*. The topic should be accurately and clearly depicted. You must include references for your information, including any pictures you take from the internet.

Research Paper: Your paper must be typed, double-spaced, a minimum of 3 pages and include the following:

- A introduction and thesis
- Correct grammar, spelling and punctuation
- Original work, absolutely no plagiarizing
- Clear and concise writing
- A minimum of 4 sources
- MLA format, see (http://owl.english.purdue.edu/owl/resource/557/01/)

PowerPoint Presentation: Your presentation should contain both a title and reference slide and a minimum of 8 informational slides, for a grand total of 10 slides. It should contain both text and graphics and when presented, demonstrates that you are prepared and understand your topic.

Brochure: Your brochure must include 6 sections and be able to fold into thirds. Each section must include visuals as well as text. The topic should be accurately and clearly depicted. You must include references for your information, including any pictures you take from the internet.

Miscellaneous: You must get prior approval for this option. This can be an activity, demonstration, model, or any other creative project that demonstrates your knowledge of the topic. This choice is the most challenging option and requires the most creativity and effort.

You may choose one of these options. Remember, the more work and effort put into your project the more points you will receive.
