

Supply List for 6th grade Math & Science Classes

Necessary for Mr. Pugh, Mrs. Keller and Mrs. Gurrola ONLY:

- 1 SINGLE Subject 8 ½ x 11 spiral notebook containing GRAPH PAPER (for math) MUST BE THIS SIZE OR Larger!*
- 1 SINGLE Subject 8 ½ x 11 spiral notebook containing COLLEGE or WIDE RULED PAPER (for science) MUST BE THIS SIZE OR Larger!*

Regarding spiral notebook size, **please pay careful attention to the measurements.** The 8 ½ x 11 size will accommodate our interactive notebook materials the best. It can be a little tricky because (most) notebooks are very close in size, but students will need **TWO 8 ½ x 11 OR LARGER spiral notebooks for math and science.**

Necessary for Mrs. Caldera and Mrs. Villanueva ONLY:

- 2 college ruled composition books (1 for math and 1 for science)

ALL 6th grade Math teachers are asking that each student have
1 ADDITIONAL composition book to be used for daily warm up work.

Requested by ALL 6th grade Math & Science Teachers: The following supplies are needed for each math / science class but can be used for all classes (Language Arts, Social Studies, etc.):

- Pencils - ideally mechanical with extra lead - especially 0.9 because it breaks the least.
- Extra erasers – either an eraser block or pencil toppers
- Manual (not battery operated) pencil sharpener (for regular or colored pencils)
- Glue sticks...students use A LOT of glue sticks in their interactive notebooks ***Class donations are also greatly appreciated!**
- Scissors
- Highlighters of assorted colors
- Colored pencils and fine tip markers – though NOT HUGE packs, we only need basic colors
- Ruler (we use this almost daily in math)
- Basic calculator (only used for some chapters) ***note: this CANNOT be on a phone or watch**
- SKINNY dry-erase white board markers (any color) ex: fine/skinny Expo marker
- Pouch or container to keep supplies organized in backpacks

Once all the Back-to-School stuff goes on clearance, you may want to grab EXTRAS of these items. Especially the spiral or composition notebooks (depending on the teacher) for second semester work. In our experience, many of the supplies above will run out or magically disappear after Winter Break and stores increase the prices later.
