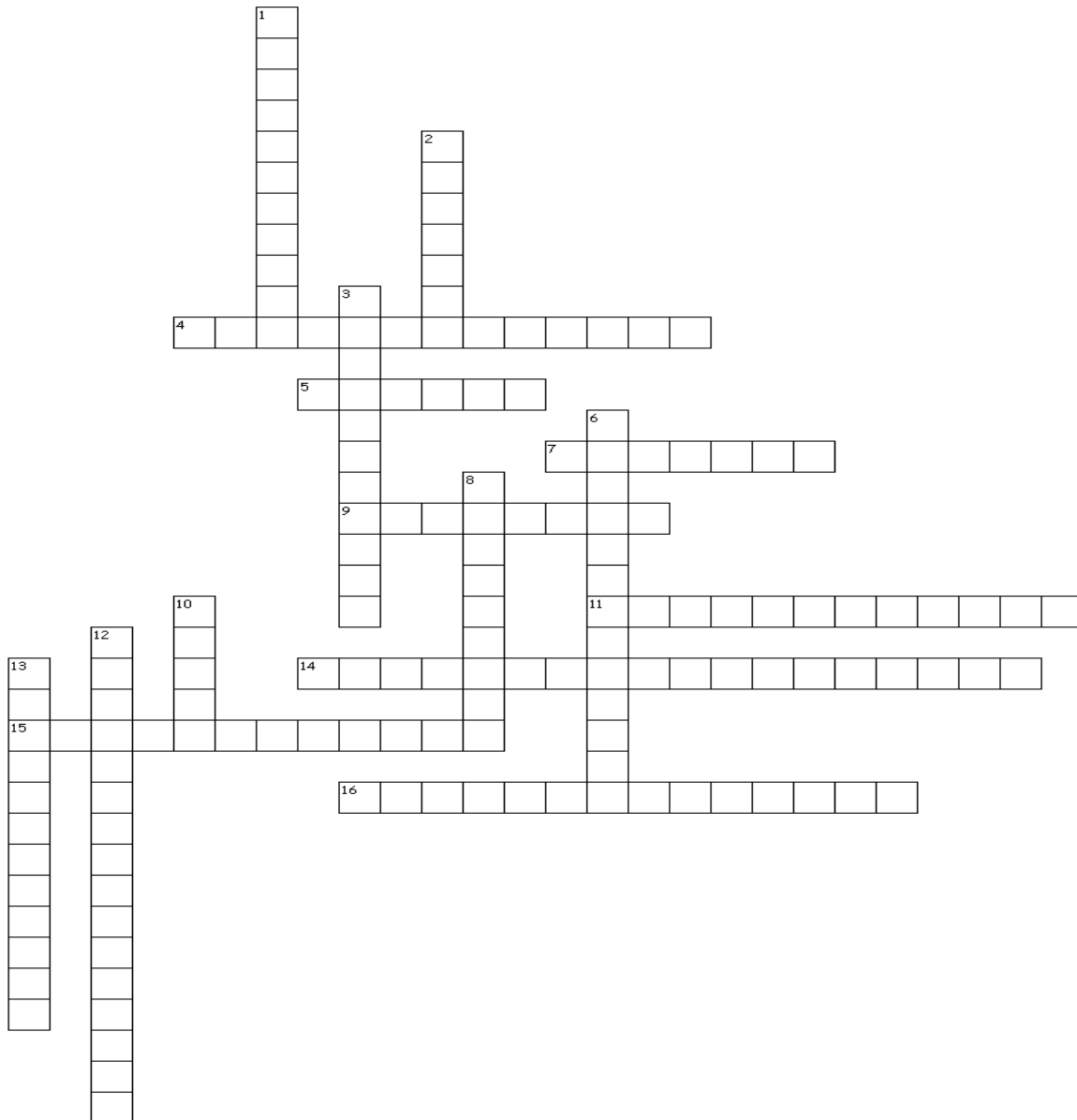


# Water in California
