**Brief Course Description:** This course meets District graduation requirements for elective credit. The AFJROTC is a leadership program that is designed to instill the value of citizenship, personal responsibility and a sense of accomplishment. All courses have two main curriculums, Aerospace Science and Leadership Education. This is a course for students who will manage and lead the cadet core. Students will complete real world assignments ensuring all AFJROTC activities and unit goals are fulfilled. Students will plan, organize and develop committees as needed to complete all unit tasks. In addition, students will be taught: principles of management, management in a working environment, establishing goals, developing plans to achieve the goals and foundations of decision-making. Students will be expected to wear the AFJROTC uniform, lead military drill and conduct inspections.
