These are the supplies that your child will use every day. Please let me know if you are unable to get any of these items and I will help you. We will be doing some art projects and science experiments. I normally ask for donations, but since I had to have everything ready before August 18th, I purchased and prepared all of our art projects. There are a few things you might need to buy for art that I didn't have in my own home or at class to give you. Art and Science Experiments are going to be optional because of the Coronavirus. I can't afford them out of my own pocket. I am sorry, but hope you'll understand. Student Supplies

- 2 - spiral notebooks for Language Arts and Math
- 6 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of #2 Ticonderoga pencils (better brands will sharpen better)
- 1 large erasers
- Colored Pencils
- Elmer's School Glue
- Plastic pencil sharpener: small, no noise, with a reservoir to hold shavings
- 2 Post-It note pads (3x3, we use them regularly)
- Lined white paper, 3 hole punched
- 2 red pens (not the click top ones, they're noisy)
- 4 Dry erase markers
- Dry eraser or soft rag/old sock to clean white board
- Dry erase board
- Yellow highlighter
- Pencil Box (max size 6" x 9" x 3")
- Ear buds or **noise cancelling headphones** (personal preference) that your child finds comfortable to wear; used daily. With multiple children working in the same area at home, the background noise is making it difficult to hear during discussions.
- Foot long ruler, optional meter stick
