The following conditions must be met for participation in Eighth Grade Promotion activities at DMMS:

1. All Library books, textbooks, and equipment must be returned or payment must be made for lost items. In addition, student lunch accounts must be current with no negative balance. It is the responsibility of each eighth grade student to clear any charges no later than Wednesday, May 27, 2020.
2. Eighth grade students attending the eighth grade dance or other activities must comply with all school policies, rules and regulations, including but not limited to school district dress code.
3. Eighth grade students with a final grade of an F in two or more core classes may lose the privilege to participate in one or more eighth grade activity, including promotion.
4. Any eighth grade student who willfully defies school personnel, policies or rules may be excluded from any or all eighth grade activities, including promotion exercises at the discretion of school administration based on student disciplinary history.
5. Any eighth grade student who receives a suspension during the week of promotion may not be permitted to participate in the promotion ceremony or eighth grade activities.
6. Any eighth grade student who willfully participates in activities which are destructive to school property or causes the District to expend money for clean up or repair shall be excluded from all eighth grade activities, including promotion. Transcripts and all school records will be held pursuant to this policy.
