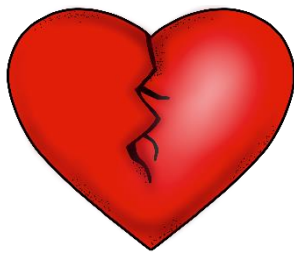

Describe a time you felt let down or disappointed. How did you handle it?



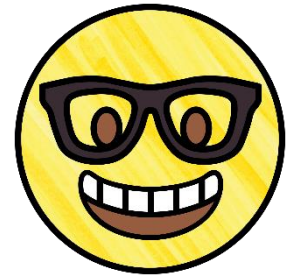
