Diane Bynum, past MVCPTA President, stated that even after 20 years the MVCPTA continues to thrive due to its strong leadership and partnership with the School Board and District.

Superintendent Communications

Superintendent Scheer reported that concerts were held by the Red, Blue and Green bands, each representing a high school and its feeder middle school band. He was excited to report that he attended the 2012 VEX Robotics World Championships in Anaheim when Murrieta Valley High School's team won the championship.

Board Communications

Trustee Ken Dickson complimented the student representatives to the Board for their comprehensive reports. He thanked Shivela Middle School's choir for their excellent performance and congratulated the District Teachers of the Year. Mr. Dickson praised the members of the Murrieta Valley Council PTA for decades of volunteerism on behalf of children.

Trustee Kris Thomasian expressed her appreciation to the press and to Karen Parris, District Media & Communications Specialist, for the recent positive news articles. She indicated that she is amazed that the MVUSD's arts and athletic programs continue to thrive in spite of the State's ongoing budget cuts to education. Mrs. Thomasian commended teachers, staff, parents and the PTA for supporting students.

Trustee Margi Wray stated that it is no surprise that students, lead by an amazing teaching staff, continue to put Murrieta on the map. She commended Sosciety Louden for being selected as Math Teacher of the Year, and noted that the highlight of her week was attending Vista Murrieta High School's Class Awards.

Trustee Robin Crist congratulated the District Teachers of the Year recipients. She reported attending the Every 15 Minutes Program at Murrieta Mesa High School that included a mock car accident depicting the fatal consequences of drinking and driving. She thanked the emergency responders that participated in the program as well as Principal Mary Walters. Ms. Crist reported that California School Boards Association has replaced their Annual Legislative Action Day with Board Member Action Day, a legislative action effort focused on going local. However, is disappointed that it will be held June 1st which conflicts with MVUSD promotions and graduations.
