Kathy Ericson, President of the Murrieta Teachers Association (MTA) commented that the Murrieta Valley Unified School District is fortunate to have quality teachers along with a community that supports them. ## **Superintendent Communications**

Superintendent Scheer praised the Student of the Month breakfast program and its founder, Sally Myers, for her vision, generosity and commitment to keep this program going year after year.
