Robin Dobisky, community member, expressed concern regarding the district's special education program.

Student ASB Representative Communications

ASB Student Representative Joell Jex highlighted student activities and upcoming events at Murrieta Valley High School.

ASB Student Representative Natacha Chanthabandith highlighted student activities and upcoming events at Murrieta Mesa High School.

ASB Student Representative Daron Loving highlighted student activities and upcoming events at Vista Murrieta High School.

Superintendent Scheer presented each Student ASB Representative with a Certificate of Appreciation and a high school sweatshirt for serving as a Student ASB Representative to the Board this past school year.

Employee Organization Communications

Chuck Smith, President of the Murrieta Teachers Association (MTA) was impressed by our student's accomplishments. He referred to the student artwork on display and commented that with all of the focus on lack of funds he sincerely hopes it does not affect this part of the curriculum. He announced that tomorrow night MTA is holding their annual Teacher Appreciation dinner at Pat & Oscar's restaurant and invited Board members to stop by. He reported that The Pep Rally for Schools will be held on May 17th at Temecula Valley High School's stadium.

It was noted that Craig Frame, President of the Murrieta Chapter of the California School Employees Association (CSEA) was absent.

Superintendent Communications

Superintendent Scheer expressed his appreciation to the Board for moving this meeting so that he may attend his son's ceremony when he receives his MBA.

Dr. Scheer reported attending Vista Murrieta High School's prom and was happy to report that students were on their best behavior and the venue was impressive. He attended a meeting with the City Manager and was pleased to learn that 40 of our high school students volunteered to plant a garden. He reported that our API scores were raised from last year.

Referring to the student artwork on display, Dr. Scheer said that it is directly related to the commitment by all staff to maintain programs and jobs by taking a reduction in pay. He indicated that the Governor has proposed two budget plans: an "all cuts" budget, and a budget if taxes are extended by the voters. He noted that the district has positioned itself to expect another \$350 reduction per student if the "all cuts" budget is enacted. He thanked the School Board for staying focused.

Board Communications

Trustee Ken Dickson congratulated students on their academic accomplishments. He reported attending the Celebrating Educators Luncheon, and the Leader Cast event which was broadcast globally and included leaders in industry, business and education. He reported attending a ChildSpree event meeting. The event will provide 200 underprivileged children with a \$125 shopping spree at JC Penney's and is being co-sponsored by the Chamber, Salvation Army and others. Mr. Dickson also reported attending the Crystal Apple Awards ceremony.

Trustee Robin Crist is scheduled to attend the California School Boards Association Delegate Assembly meeting and looks forward to interacting with CSBA's newly elected officials. Ms. Crist remarked that she looks forward to attending MTA's Teacher Appreciation Dinner tomorrow night and plans to also attend the rally. She expressed her appreciation to our teachers, students and staff that worked so hard this year as reflected in the API scores.

Trustee Margi Wray was surprised by how fast the school year went by. She remarked that the quality of experience provided to our students is a direct reflection of this evening's staff that were recognized.

He attended Vista Murrieta High School's Open House and witnessed students excited about their classes and he had an opportunity to listen to the Jazz band with Dr. Scheer.
