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Superintendent Communications Superintendent Scheer reported speaking at a High School Student Leadership Summit held at Vista Murrieta High School and said how impressed he was by the caliber of students in Murrieta. He visited McElhinney Middle School classrooms and attended the Murrieta Valley High School basketball game. He commended Murrieta Valley High School Principal Renate Jefferson for having the courage to place restrictions on objectionable dancing at MVHS school dances. He reminded the Board that next year Murrieta Mesa High School will have a full complement of students, 9th through 12th grades. Dr. Scheer reported that senior staff were invited to take a tour of the new Loma Linda Medical Center in Murrieta and indicated that it is an impressive facility.

Board Communications Trustee Kris Thomasian reported attending the District Spelling Bee and expressed her appreciation to staff that planned the event. She also attended a Southwest Riverside Autism Taskforce meeting and indicated that our Special Education staff made a presentation to the committee on our Special Education Parent Advisory Committee (SEPAC). Trustee Robin Crist congratulated the Murrieta students that won at the Council PTA Reflections Program and indicated that they will now go on to compete at the 23rd District PTA level. Trustee Margi Wray thanked Robin Crist for hosting the Spelling Bee and Kris Thomasian for serving as a judge. She congratulated the Murrieta Valley High School Dance Team and Coach, Hollee Romero, for placing 12th in the Hip Hop and 16th in Jazz out of 44 teams at the Dance Team National Championship held in Florida.

Trustee Ken Dickson thanked the Rail Ranch Dance Team for their dance presentation this evening. He expressed his appreciation to Renate Jefferson for her decision relative to school dances. He remarked that the Spelling Bee is an extremely positive event which provides a considerable amount of learning for students. Mr. Dickson encouraged everyone to attend the hypnotist show this weekend.

Trustee Paul Diffley commended Mrs. Crist for facilitating the Spelling Bee. He remarked that he is thrilled to have a new medical facility in our city. He commented on our Autism program and is pleased that we are doing well and addressing autism in a methodical way.
