


All seniors must order their cap and gown units before February 1, 2024 to avoid a late fee.

STUDENTS AND PARENTS WITH A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER SHOULD CREATE AN FSA ID. SAVE YOUR LOGIN INFO BECAUSE THE FAFSA NEEDS TO BE SUBMITED EVERY YEAR THAT YOU RETURN TO COLLEGE!

STEP 1: GO TO FSAID.ED.GOV AND CREATE A

**USERNAME AND PASSWORD** 

STEP 2: ENTER YOUR NAME, DATE OF BIRTH,

AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

STEP 3: ENTER YOUR PERSONAL EMAIL, PHONE

**NUMBER, AND MAILING ADDRESS** 

STEP 4: SELECT YOUR CHALLENGE QUESTIONS

AND INPUT YOUR ANSWERS

STEP 5: REVIEW AND CONFIRM YOUR

**INFORMATION IS CORRECT** 

STEP 6: VERIFY YOUR PHONE NUMBER AND

**EMAIL, IF AVAILABLE** 

STEP 7: YOUR FSA ID HAS BEEN CREATED!
