

Emotion Management Tips



Use a stop signal. Using a stop signal send a message to your brain to stop and tells it it's time to redirect one's thoughts. Some stop words that a child can use are: Stop, chill out, hold on, let's take a minute, and relax.



Name your feeling. Your child should out loud or using their "self-talk" state the specific feeling they're feeling. Such feeling like sad, mad, frustrated, jealous, frustrated, and/or lonely.




